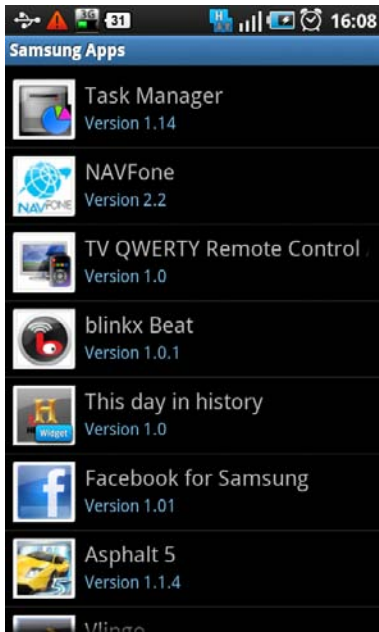
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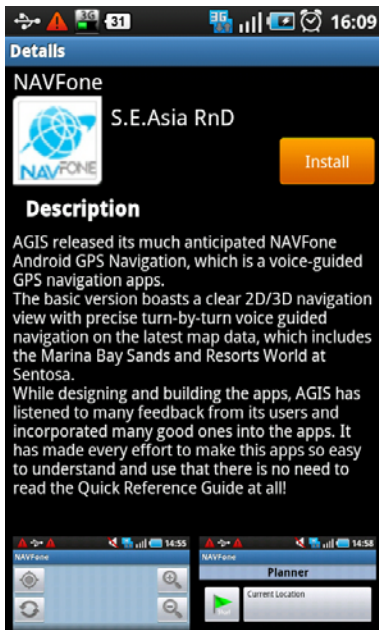

### 1.1 Installing NAVFone

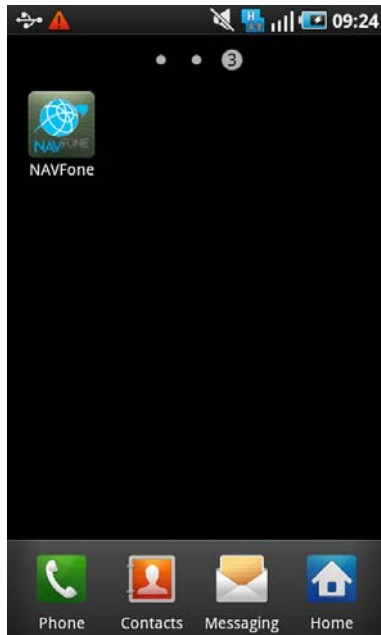


- Goto Application > Samsung Apps and browse for NAVFone

## 2.0 Using NAVFone

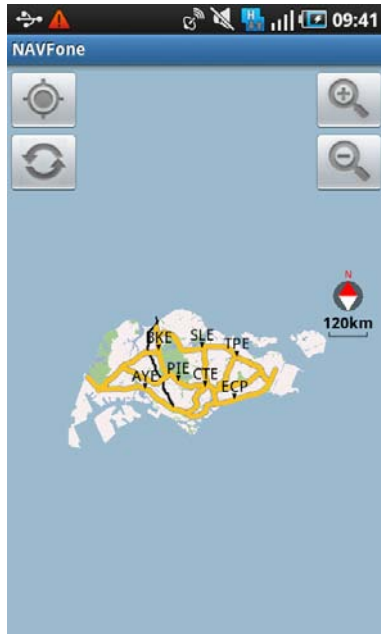
### 2.1 Launching the application & activation

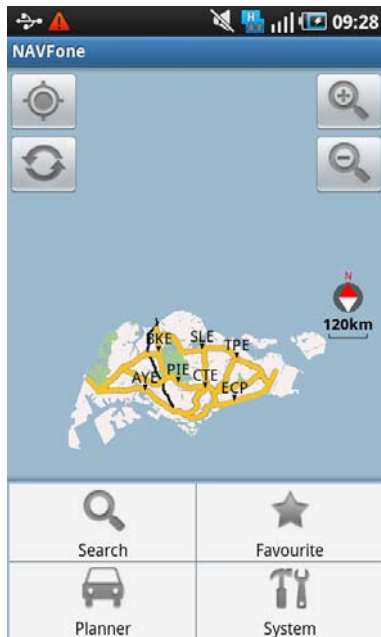

## 4.0 Menu

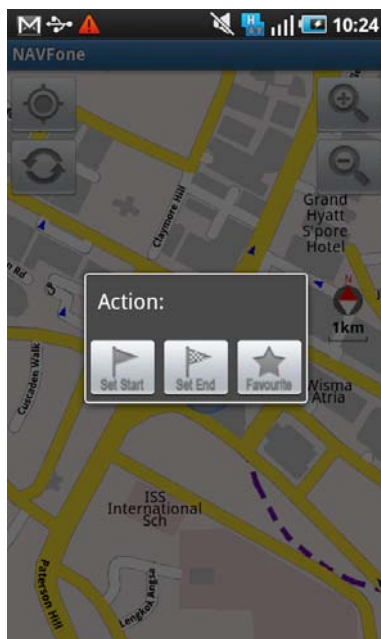


There are 2 types of menu in NAVFone

- Main Menu  
Press the  button to access.

The following items will be available;

1. Search (See Section X)
2. Favourite (See Section X)
3. Planner (See Section X)
4. System (See Section X)

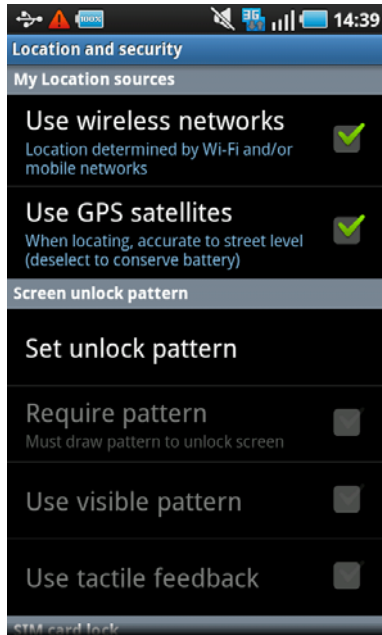


- Action Menu  
Press and hold (Long Press) on the Map View. The Action Menu will pop-up.

The following items will be available;

1. **Favourite** - Add selected result to Favourite list
2. **Set Start** - Set selected result as navigation start point.
3. **Set End** - Set selected result as navigation end point.

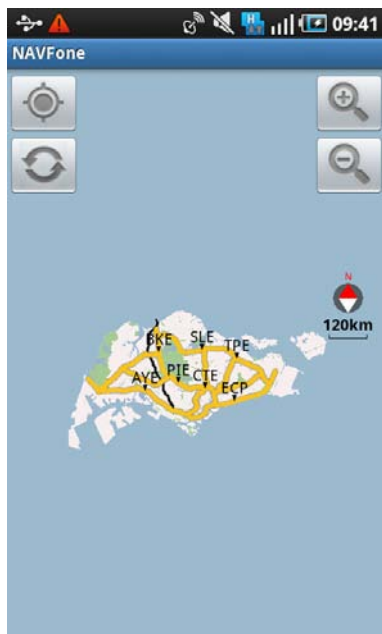
## 5.0 Position





Depending on available services, NAVFone uses a combination of cellular, Wi-Fi, and GPS to determine your location. If you're not within a clear line of sight to GPS satellites, NAVFone can determine your location using Wi-Fi<sup>3</sup>. If you're not in range of any Wi-Fi, NAVFone can determine your location using cellular towers.

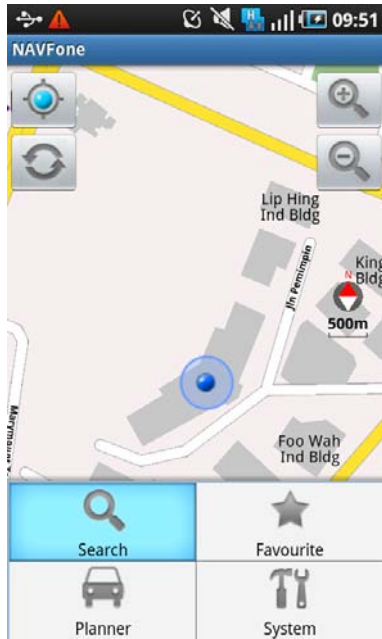
It is important that your phone is correctly set.

- Goto Setting > Location and Security
- Enable "Use Wireless Network"
- Enable "Use GPS Satellites"



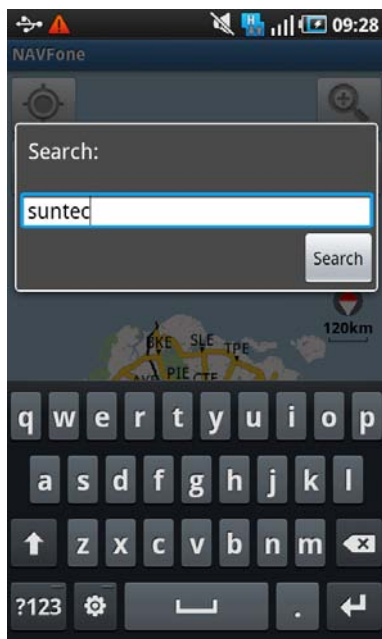
- To view your location, press the  button. Once pressed, your location will be shown on the map.
- To stop showing your position, press the  button.

## 6.0 Search

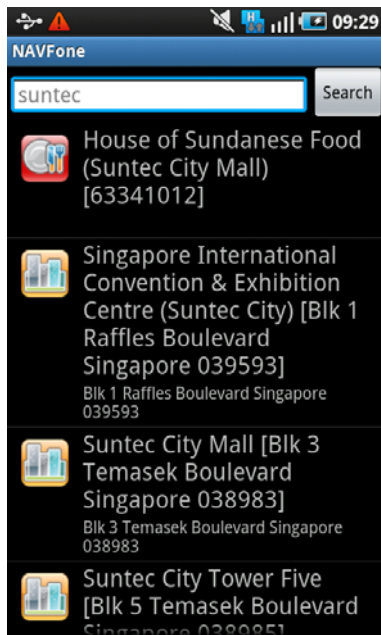


To search for locations,

- Goto Main Menu > Search

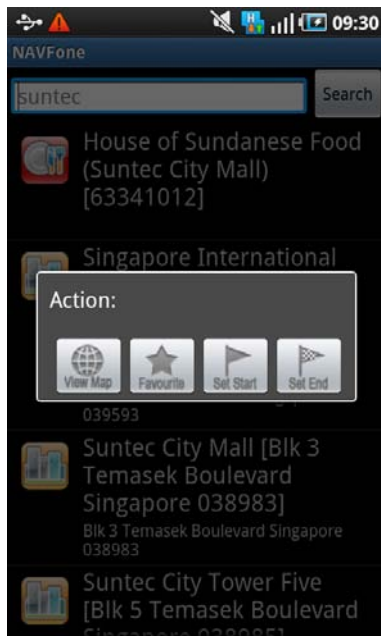


- Key in the location



A list of result will be shown.

- Press and hold on a result and a list of action will be available
1. **View Map** - View selected result on map
  2. **Favourite** - Add selected result to Favourite list

  4. **Set End** - Set selected result as navigation end point.



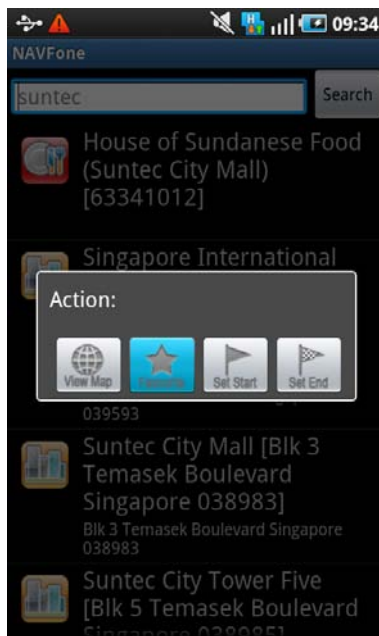
## 7.0 Favourite

Favourite (also known as waypoints or bookmarks) are points that can be created and displayed in the map as an icon with a label attached to it. All waypoint can be saved for later use and easy reference. Each waypoint's label, icon type and size can be set to differentiate one from another. A short note can also add to it.

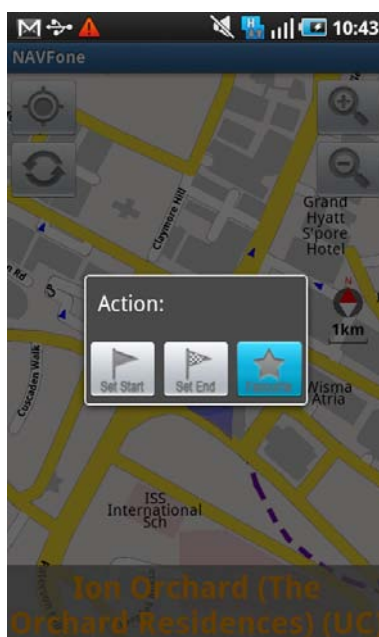
### 7.1 Acquiring Waypoints

There are 3 methods to add waypoints.

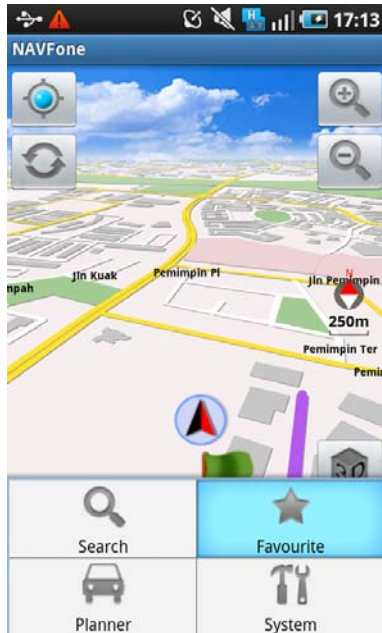
- Search Result



- From Map View

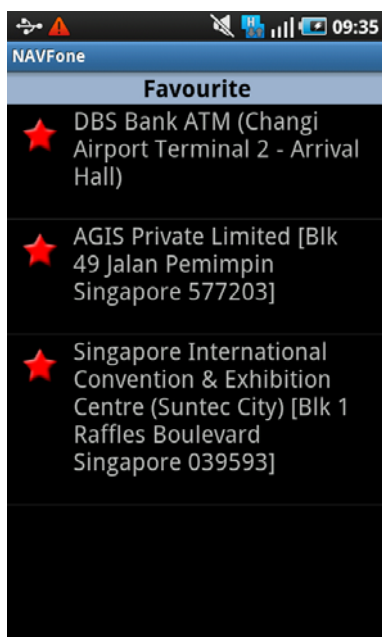


## 7.2 Favourite Manager



Created waypoints will be listed within the Favourite Manager.

- Goto Main Menu > Favourite



A list of bookmarks will be shown.



- Press and hold on a result and a list of action will be available

1. View Map - View selected result on map
2. Delete – Remove selected result.
3. Set Start - Set selected result as navigation start point.
4. Set End - Set selected result as navigation end point.
5. Edit - Modify selected waypoint details. The following items are available:

#### **Name**

- Add a customise name or use the default name.

#### **Note**

- Add notes or comments.

#### **Change Icon**

- Select the various Icon type

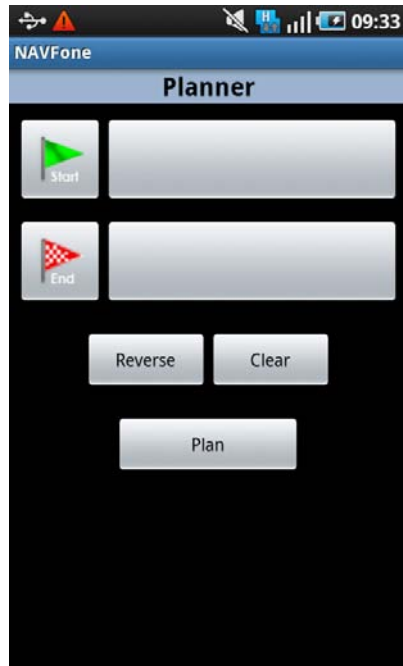
#### **Show On Map**

- Toggle on and off. If off, the selection item will not be shown on map.

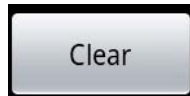
## 8.0 Route Planning

### 8.1 Route Planning For Driving

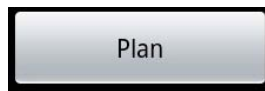
A start point and a destination must be clearly defined to successfully plan a route. In NAVFone, there are a few way to set the start point and destination.



Toggles the start and end points



Clear the start and end points



Press to start routing, based on the selected start and end points

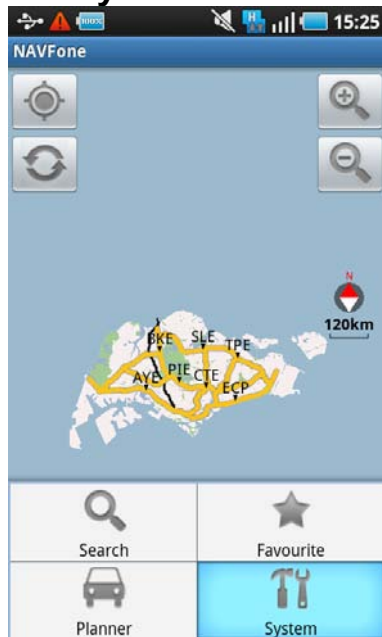
#### 8.1.1 Set Start Position

<b>Via Current Location (Recommended)</b>	The start position will be the current GPS location.
<b>Via Search</b>	Use the search menu for location lookup
<b>Via Favourite</b>	Choose from the waypoints in the Favourite Manager.

#### 8.1.2 Set Destination

<b>Via Search</b>	Use the search menu for location lookup
<b>Via Favourite</b>	Choose from the waypoints in the Favourite Manager.

## 9.0 System

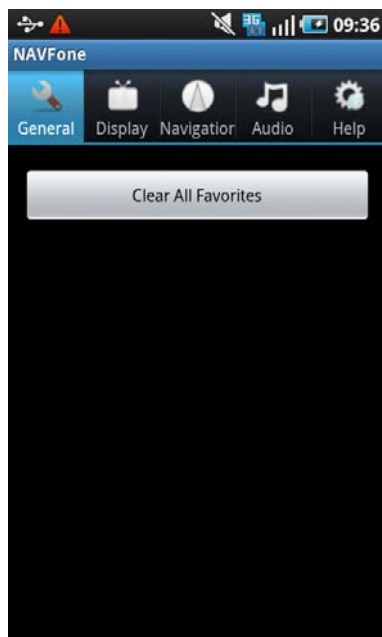


This feature allows NAVFone functional setting to be changed.

- Goto Main Menu > System

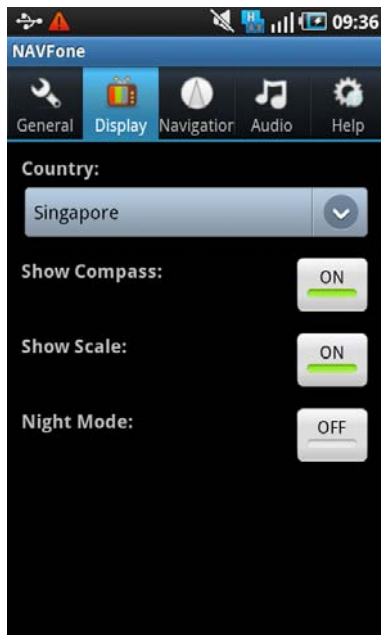
The following system setting are available;

1. General
2. Display
3. Navigation
4. Audio
5. Help



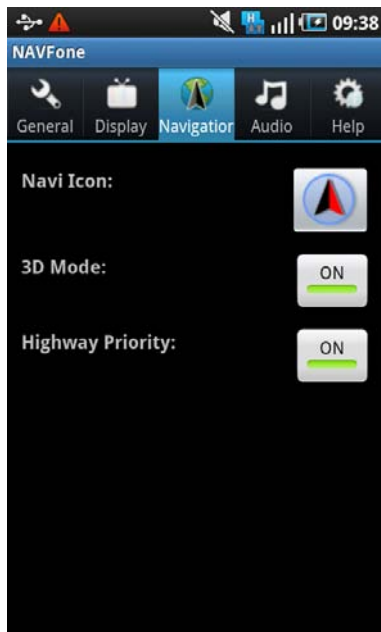
### General

- **Clear All Favourites** - Deletes all saved location bookmarks.



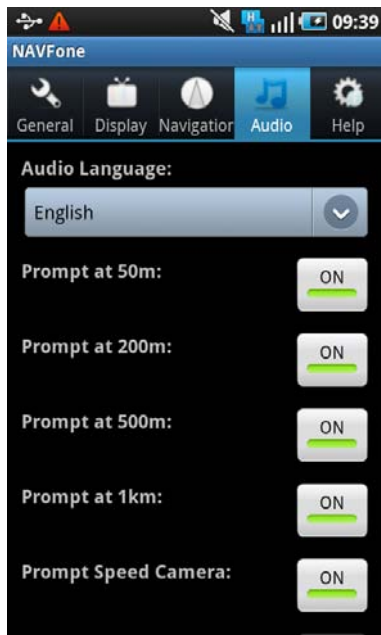
### Display

- **Country** – Select map
- **Show Compass** – Toggles on and off.
- **Show Scale** – Toggles on and off.
- **Night Mode** – Changes the map display contrast for night time driving. Toggles on and off.



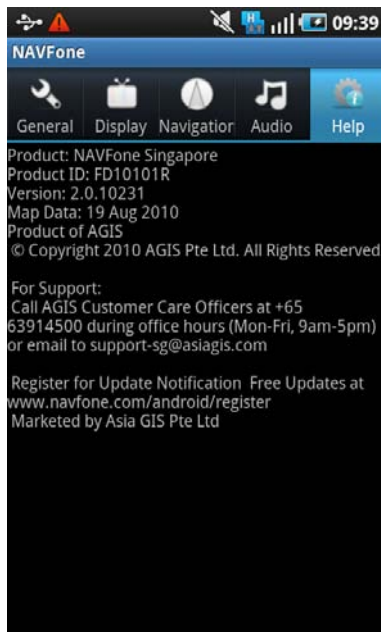
### Navigation

- **Navi Icon** – Change the icon type.
- **3D Mode** – Toggles on (therefore 2D view) and off.
- **Highway Priority** – Toggles on and off. If off, highway & expressway will be avoided in the routing, whenever possible.



### Audio

- Audio Language – Select Language
- Prompt at 50m, 200m, 500m & 1km – Toggle on and off. No prompt will be heard if off.
- Prompt Speed Camera - Toggle on and off. No warning prompt will be heard if off.
- Prompt ERP - Toggle on and off. No warning prompt will be heard if off.
