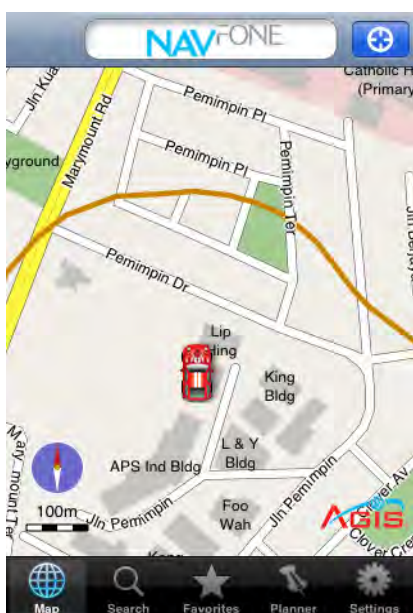

## 1.0 Using NAVFone



To launch **NAVFone**

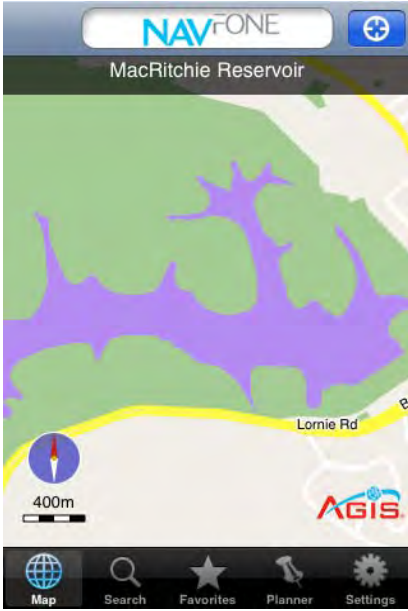
- Tap on the NAVFone GPS Navigation icon on your Home Screen



When NAVFone is initialized, it would show the map and immediately pin-point your current location.

This location is demarcated with the icon of a red car. (This can be changed in the settings page)

## 2.0 The Map View



Map View

All maps shown are always orientated to the North.

Select an object by tapping on the object. The name of the item selected is shown at the top of the map.

The scale on the bottom right changes according to the zoom level and provides a rough estimate of distances between places and objects.

This Map View window represents the main screen.



Quick Access Menu


Double tap **anywhere** on the map to call up the Quick Access Menu (QAM).

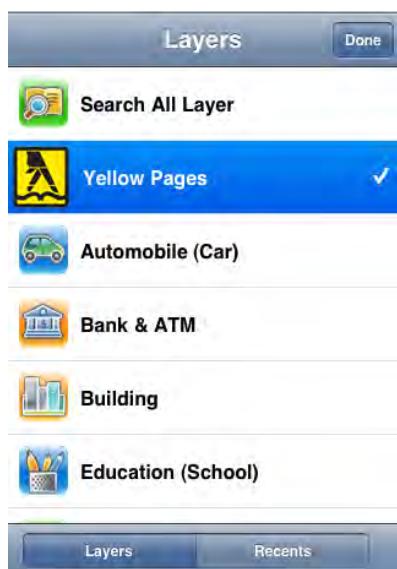
The QAM and its functions will be further explained on the later section of this guide.

### 3.0 Search by Category Layer



To access the Search feature

- Tap on Search
- Select a search layer by tapping on  .



- For Layer search, select Layer
- Tap on Done
- **Select “Search All Layer” for a Generic Search**



- Key in the search query



- Tap on **Sort By A-Z** to sort alphabetically.
- Tap on **Sort By Km** to sort by distance.
- Tap on the result for a detailed view.



To set selected result as the Start Point:

- Tap on Set as Start

To set result as the Destination:

- Tap on GO

To view the selected result on map:

- Tap on View on Map

To search for various amenities in the vicinity of the selected result:

- Tap on Search Nearby

To Add this search result as a Favorites:

- Tap Add to Favorites

To Call the contact number provided (Only for Yellow Pages Data)

- Tap on Call

## 4.0 Navigation Planner

### 4.1 Overview



Tap on Planner

The following items are available.

1. Start
  - Defines the beginning point of your journey
2. End
  - Defines the end point of your journey
3. Reverse
  - Swaps the Start and End locations
4. Clear Locations
  - Clears the Start and End locations
5. GO
  - Begins the navigation process

### 4.2 Setting the Start & End Point



1. Via the Quick Access Menu (QAM)
  - Double tap on selected location on the map
  - On the QAM, tap on Set as Start. This will set the selected location as the route Start Point.
  - The same process can be used to set the End point. Once the location has been selected, tap on Set as End.



2. Via the Search Result (Refer to 4.0 Search)

- Tap on Set as Start to select the location as the route Start Point.
- Tap on Set as End to select the location as the route End Point.



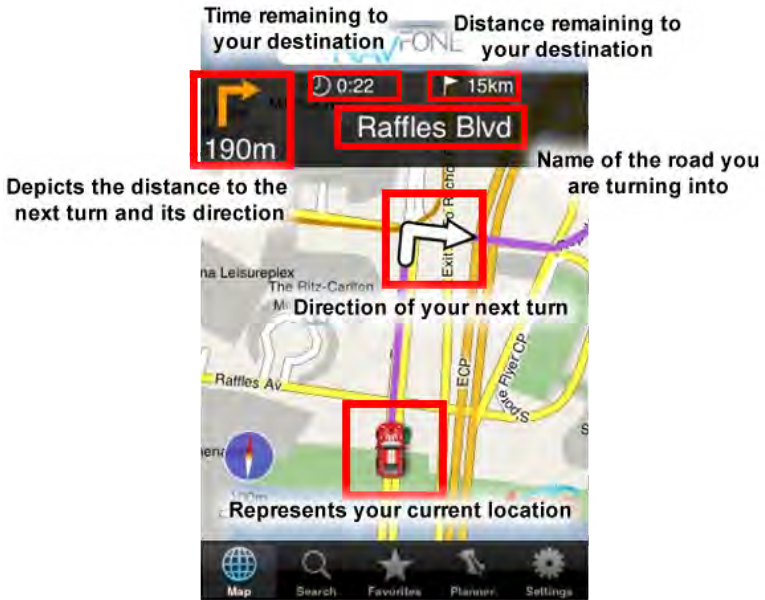
3. Via Favorites (Refer to 6.0 Favorites)

- Tap on Set as Start to select the location as the route Start Point.
- Tap on GO to select the location as the destination.

### 4.3 Navigation

Upon determining your start and end points, NAVFone will immediately begin navigation.

You will then be presented with the following screen.



## 5.0 Favorites

Favorites are points that can be created and displayed in the map as an icon with a label attached to it. All Favourites can be saved for later use and easy reference. Each Favourite label, icon type and size can be set customized. A short note can also be added.

### 5.1 Create a New Favorite

There are 2 methods to create new Favorites.

#### 5.1.1 Via the Quick Access Menu (QAM)



- Double tap on selected location on the map



- Enter a name for the Favorite or use the default name.
- Optionally, you may key in a Note or change the Icon.
- Tap on Save.

### 5.1.2 Via the Search Result



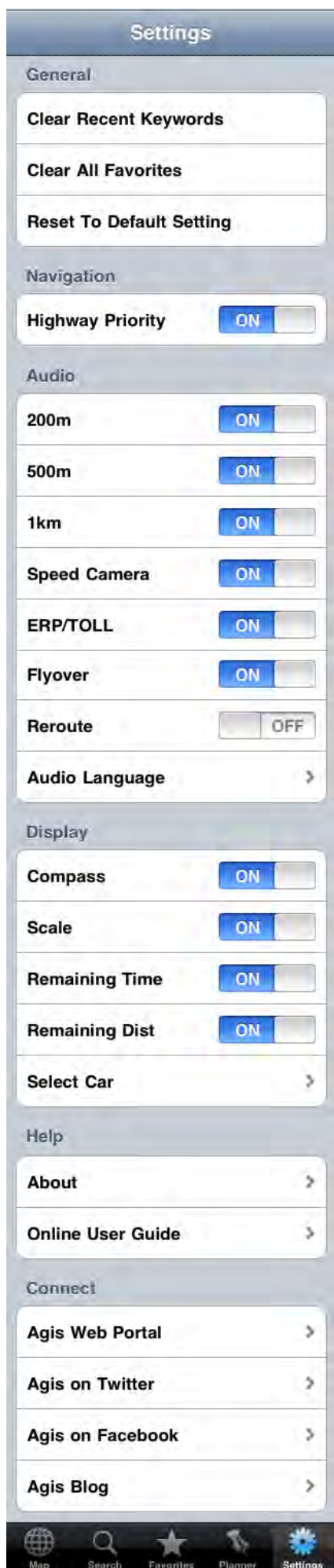
- Tap on the selected result to view the Details



- Tap on Add to Favorites



- Enter a name for the Favorite or use the default name.
- Optionally, you may key in a Note or change the Icon.
- Tap on Save.



## 6.0 Settings

This feature allows you to change certain NAVFone options and settings.

### General

- Clear your recent keywords
- Clear your favorite records
- Reset to Default Setting

### Navigation

Highway Priority

- Select your preference for navigation via Highway or otherwise

### Audio

Enable/Disable audio prompts at

- 200m,
- 500m and
- 1km

Enable/Disable audio prompts for speed camera

- speed check areas
- ERP/Toll areas
- Flyovers

Select your audio language

### Display

Toggle

- compass display
- scale display
- remaining time display
- remaining distance display
- selection of your preferred car
